



INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES FOR PHYSICAL ENDURANCE TEST (PET) FOR THE POST OF WARDER (POST CODE-37/13) IN DEPARTMENT OF PRISONS, GOVT. OF NCT OF DELHI

The reporting time at the test centre will be 07.00 AM to 07.30 A.M.
Entry will NOT be allowed after 07.30 A.M. in any case

1. In accordance with the DSSSB Notices No. 411 dated 18.07.2016 and No. 468 dated 31.01.2017, 115 candidates have provisionally qualified for appearing in Physical Endurance Test (PET) / Physical Standards Essential (PSE) measurements, for selection to the post of Warder under Post Code 37/13.
2. The Physical Endurance Test (PET) / Physical Standards Essential (PSE) measurements are qualifying in nature as per recruitment rules.
3. e-Admit cards are being uploaded on the above-mentioned DSSSB web site and the above-mentioned candidates may download their e-admit card **w.e.f. 21.04.2017 at 11.00 AM to 05.05.2017 up to 11.59 PM**. 4. **Any candidate without valid e- Admit Card in two pages, second page containing a 4"x 6" photograph ensuring clear identification and his / her Photo identity card shall NOT be allowed to enter the test venue under any circumstances. Second page of the e-Admit Card shall be retained by the officers at the PET venue.**
5. Any kind of malpractices such as impersonation, canvassing etc. shall invite penal action including rejection from present test as well as debarring from future examinations.
6. The candidature to the Physical Endurance Test (PET) / Physical Standards Essential (PSE) measurements is entirely provisional and subject to the outcome of direction/decision/order of any Court of Law and mere issue of Admit Card or appearance at the Test does not entitle the candidate to any claim for the post.
7. The Board reserves the right to cancel a part of or the entire process of Test due to administrative reasons and in case of unfair means, cheating or other irregularities/malpractices noticed by the Board. The Board also reserves the right to cancel the Test Venue and divert the candidates to a new Venue, if required. **No request for change in date, time and Venue of the PET will be accepted under any circumstances at any stage.**
8. The Board reserves the right to reject the candidature of any ineligible candidate at any stage of recruitment/selection.
