- 1. Reporting time for the candidates at the examination centre on the day of examination is between <u>08:30 A.M.</u> to <u>09:30 A.M.</u> The examination will commence at 10.30 A.M. sharp. Entry to the Examination Centre will be closed at 9.30 A.M for candidates. No candidate will be allowed to enter the Examination Centre after <u>9.30 A.M.</u> under any circumstances what so ever.
- 2. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre without Admit card and without any I.D. proof (in original) under any circumstances.

- 3. The candidates are required to bring their recent coloured passport size photograph which required to be pasted on 1st Page of Admit Card. Further candidate is also directed to bring one post card size photograph (4"x6") which required to be pasted on the second page of Admit Card and hand over the same to the invigilator on the Exam day after signing and affixing thumb impression in presence of invigilator.
- 4. The duration of examination is of 2 hours from 10.30 am to 12.30 pm [except post code 02/13, 03/13 & 197/14, AE (Civil)]. There will be 200 Objective type/multiple choice questions carrying one mark each (see Scheme of Examination for details).
- 5. The duration of Examination for the post code 02/13, 03/13 & 197/14 AE (Civil) is of 3 Hours from 10.30 am to 1.30 pm.
- 6. There will be negative marking for wrong answers 0.25 mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- 7. The e-admit card for the above mentioned post codes are being uploaded on the website of DSSSB i.e. www.dsssb.delhigovt.nic.in and eligible candidates may download their e-admit card w.e.f. 24/04/2017 (10.00 a.m.) to 05/05/2017 (11.59 p.m).
- 8. Detailed instructions to download e-admit cards are available on official website of the Board. In case any candidate find difficulties in downloading the e-admit card he/she may contact the Board Office (IT Branch) on Telephone No.22379204/ 22370307. Lists of eligible candidates are being uploaded on the website.
- 9. The e-Admit cards are being issued purely on the basis of information furnished by the candidate in his/her application. The DSSSB has not verified/scrutinized this information and therefore, mere appearance at the examination does not, in any way, entitle him/her to claim for the post.
- 10. The candidature will be treated as **invalid**, *ab-initio*, in case he/she does not fulfill the eligibility criteria. Candidate should satisfy himself/herself regarding the possession of the required qualifications, age, caste etc. as stipulated for the post he/she has applied for, <u>as on cutoff date</u>, before appearing in the examination.
- 11. The OMR Answer Sheet and 2nd page of Admit Card will be taken back after completion of the exam by the Invigilator immediately. However, the candidates are allowed to take back home the question booklet after the completion of exam. A candidate, under no circumstances, shall be allowed to leave exam centre before expiry of 2 hours.



- 12. The questions will be bilingual i.e. in Hindi & in English, wherever applicable, except for the test of language section of the paper.
- 13. The Board reserves the right to reject the candidature of any ineligible candidate at any stage of recruitment. Further, candidature of any candidate is purely provisional, at every stage until he is offered appointment by the concerned Department to which the post belongs.
- 14. The candidature of the candidate to the written Examination is entirely provisional and subject to the outcome of any direction/decision/order/pronouncement of any Court of Law and mere issue of e-admit Card or appearance at Examination does not entitle him/her to any claim for the post.

N.B.-Candidates are strictly advised not to bring mobile phones/cellular phones, ear phones, books, notes, electronic watches with facility of calculation, calculators, and pagers or any other communication device, bags etc. inside the Center premises. Part-I (MCQ/Objective Type)

- General Intelligence & reasoning ability- same as in Tier-I but with slightly higher level
- Quantitative Aptitude- In addition to Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities as in Tier-I with slightly higher level, there will be questions on data interpretation &Analysis.
- In addition to topics given for General Awareness Tier-I, there shall be question on History, culture, demography, geography & economy of Delhi, Administrative set up and Governance in NCT of Delhi, various schemes of Delhi govt.
- English Language & Comprehension same as in Tier-I but with slightly higher level.

Part-II (Descriptive)

Essay Writing: Topics on current affairs of national and International interests, culture society, women empowerment, environment, Relation with neighboring countries, etc.

Letter Writing: Letters on various subjects like request to Registering authorities for issue of birth certificates, marriage registration, to get commercial loan form banks, to get membership from various councils, lodging police complaints letter to Editor of a newspaper highlighting social evils, letter to Municipal Authorities highlighting various civic issues like road, sanitation, street lights etc.

Expansion of Ideas in English Language: Candidate will be required to elaborate their ideas on specific quotes/ topics for example, " Everything that glitter is not gold; As you sow, so shall you reap: once in a blue moon" and on other topics of genera interests.

 Subject / Qualification Related paper:- As per qualification prescribed in the RRs/ given in Advt.

SYLLABUS: (for One Tier, Two Tier and Three Tier Examination Schemes)□□One Tier Examination:-Section-A:

- (i) General Awareness: Questions will be designed to test the ability of the candidate's General Awareness of the environment around him/her and its application to society. The questions will be designed to test knowledge of Current Events and of such matter of everyday observation as may be expected of an educated person. The test will also include questions relating to History, Polity, Constitution, Sports, Art & Culture, Geography, Economics, Everyday Science, Scientific Research, National/International Organizations /Institutions etc.
- (ii) General Intelligence & Reasoning Ability: The syllabus of General Intellegence & Reasoning Ability includes questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. Test may include questions on analogies, similarities, differences, space visualization, problem solving, analysis, judgment, decision making, visual memory, discrimination, observation, relationship, concepts, arithmetical reasoning, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series etc.
- (iii) Arithmetical & Numerical Ability: The test of Arithmetical and Numerical Abilities will cover Number Systems including questions on Simplification, Decimals, Fractions, L.C.M., H.C.F., Ratio & Proportion, Percentage, Average, Profit & Loss, Discount, Simple & Compound Interest, Mensuration, Time & Work, Time & Distance, Tables & Graphs etc. of 10th level.
- (iv) & (v) Hindi Language & Comprehension and English Language & Comprehension: In addition to the testing of candidate's understanding and comprehension of the English and Hindi Languages, questions on its Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms and its correct usage etc. would also be covered.
