**REVISED RESULT NOTICE NO: 137
JUNIOR ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEER
UNDER POST CODE- 68/24
DELHI POLLUTION CONTROL COMMITTEE**

1. The earlier result for shortlisting of the candidates for Tier-II exam for the Post Code 68/24 was declared vide Result Notice No.95 dated 17.09.2025 and however, the vacancies advertised was cancelled earlier vide Notice dated 29.09.2025 for the Post of **Junior Environmental Engineer under Post Code 68/24 in Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC)**.
2. Now the cancellation notice dated 29.09.2025 is hereby revoked vide notice No. F.1(255)P&P-1/DSSSB/2024/Advt./I/134410/2026 dated 03.02.2026 to the extent of 11 vacancies reserved for OBC category only. The vacancies of other categories shall be treated as NIL.
3. Accordingly, the earlier result for the Post Code 68/24 declared vide Result Notice No.95 dated 17.09.2025 has been superseded.
4. The DSSSB vide its advertisement No. 05/24 read with Corrigendum dated 02.08.2024, 14.10.2024, 15.04.2025 & 08.07.2025 & Notice dated 03.02.2026 has revised the vacancies as total – 11 in OBC Category.
5. Based on the performance in the Tier-I written examination (online Mode), a total of 150 candidates who obtained marks above or equal to cut-off marks in OBC category, as detailed below, have been provisionally shortlisted to appear in Tier-II examination, subject to the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms. The shortlisted candidates shall be called for Tier-II examination separately.

6. Further, since documents have not been called from the candidates along with the application forms as such detailed scrutiny regarding eligibility has not been carried out, and therefore, mere inclusion of names in the list of candidates shortlisted for appearing in Tier-II Examination does not entitle them any right over the post.
7. As per the Board Policy the minimum qualifying marks in the examination for UR & EWS Category Candidate is 40%, for OBC candidate is 35% and for SC, ST & PwBD candidate is 30%.

8. The details of Tier-II examination shall be notified separately by the Board. The candidates are advised to check the Board's website regularly.

9. The above short-listing for Tier-II Exam for the post of **Environmental Engineer under Post Code- 68/24 in Delhi Pollution Control Committee (DPCC)** will be subject to outcome of pending court cases, if any.
10. While every care has been taken in preparing the result, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
