ORDER

Whereas, Mr. Manish Rana S/o Mr. Bhim Singh having Date of Birth : 23.07.1996 r/o H.No. 348, Mukhmelpur, Delhi, who appeared in the examination of Post Code 86/17, Warder, Delhi Prison Department under roll No. 2890094262 / 11250400196 was debarred vide order No. F.55(155)/Exam/DSSSB/2019/Pt. File/201 - 211 dated 16.07.2020 from any examination conducted / to be conducted by the DSSSB for life time w.e.f 18.06.2019.

And whereas, said Mr. Manish Rana challenged the abovesaid debarment order dated 16.07.2020 before the Honb'le Central Administrative Tribunal, New Delhi vide O.A. No. 891 / 2023 titled as "Manish Rana s Vs. DSSSB and Ors."

And whereas, the Honb'le Central Administrative Tribunal, New Delhi vide order dated 06.08.2020 disposed the case having operative part of the order as under :-

"2. Learned counsel for the parties fairly states that the issues raised in the present OA are identical to those in OA No. 3775/2024. It is not disputed that the post involved is the same, and that the candidature of similarly situated candidates was also cancelled on similar grounds.

3. We are of the view that we do not intend to take a divergent view and shall be bound by the view and observations made in OA No. 3775/2024. We take note that OA No. 3775/2024 has already been decided. The relevant portion of the said order, particularly Paragraphs 7 and 8, is reproduced below for clarity:

"7. Considering the above and following the decision of the Hon'ble High Court, we are of the opinion that the O.A. can be disposed of with direction to the respondents to issue proper show cause notice to the applicant giving him time to respond to the same.

8. Needless to say, the impugned debarment order dated 16.07.2020 is quashed. Let the DSSSB complete this exercise within a period of 3 months. In the meantime, while the decision on his alleged misconduct is still pending, the applicant shall be at liberty to apply and participate in any of the recruitment examinations conducted by DSSSB for which he is eligible."

4. In view of the above, and as the facts and circumstances of the present OA are identical to OA No. 3775/2024, the present Original Application is also disposed of in terms of the above directions.

5. There shall be no order as to costs. Pending Miscellaneous Applications, if any, also stand disposed of.

And, whereas a Show cause Notice No. F.1(8751)/LC/DSSSB/2023/ dated 04.09.2025 was issued to above named candidate Mr. Manish Rana on undermentioned ground with the direction to submit his written explanation within 15 days of receipt of above said show cause notice, as to why appropriate action should not be taken against him as per rule

"The still photograph obtained from EdCIL matches with the photograph of 2nd page of Admit Card of Written Examination whereas all other photographs available in dossier matches with the 2nd page of Admit Card of PET Examination. It is therefore evident that the candidate appeared in PET whereas his impersonator appeared in written examination."

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And whereas above named candidate Mr. Manish Rana submitted written reply on 22.09.2025 stating that allegation of impersonation are not tenable. The main contents of reply of show cause notice are as under :-

"Regarding the allegation of Impersonation :

1. During the PET as well as Written Examination, At the time of Verification of the Documents with the data Available on Admit card including the photograph, the Invigilator thoroughly inspected and matched the details. Then only signed my admit card and allowed me to appear for the examination. This fact is clear enough to prove that no impersonation was done at any stage.

2. As per the order dated- 16-07-2020, I was debarred by DSSSB w.e.f. 18-06-2019 for the period of lifetime. But this fact of I being debarred came to my knowledge only when I visited the DSSSB enquiry counter on 09-01-2023 for making me absent in the result of tier 3 skill test/trade test for the post code 18/19 i.e. Fire Operator in Delhi Fire Service.

3. Despite being declared debarred from 18-06-2019, I was continuously receiving e-mails and SMS from DSSSB to download admit card for examination for the post codes mentioned in the table below.

Out of these examinations, I appeared in some of these examinations and successfully got myself verified by the Invigilator on the basis of protocols set by DSSSB and then allowed me to enter in the examination hall. This is another fact describes that no Impersonation was done at any stage.

4. In February 2021, I received another E-mail from DSSSB for Mandatory Updation of Personal details and upload postcard size photograph by 21-02-2021 in my OARS account.

After this mandatory updation I was again called by DSSSB for one more examination i.e. 95/20 for the post of Junior Assistant scheduled on 31-08-2021.

If I would have done any impersonation at any stage then why DSSSB would have allowed me to appear in above mentioned examinations clearing all the verifications as well as why would DSSSB have asked me to update my registration details.

- Being debarred by DSSSB from 18-06-2019 as per order dated 16-07-2020, I was again & again called for the examinations scheduled for more than 3 years and after reaching on the venue getting myself verified by all the set of rules and verification process set by DSSSB and Even Mandatory updation in OARS Account

is Another BIG, CLEAR & EVIDENT fact that no impersonation was done in Any Examination at any stage."

And whereas the case of above named candidate Mr. Manish Rana was placed before the committee constituted vide order No. F.4(520)/P&P-II/DSSSB/2023/587 dated 06.06.2023. The committee examined his case on 08.10.2025 and decided to refer the case for forensic examination.

And whereas, the forensic report of FSL, New Delhi concluded that signature of the candidate on two occasions i.e., the day of Written Examination & PET Examination have not been written by one person.

And whereas, the above forensic report and related records of above named candidate Mr. Manish Rana is again placed before the above referred committee. The committee after examination of related records arrived at conclusion that signature of the candidate in two occasions i.e., on the day of his CBT Examination & PET Examination are concluded by the forensic expert that they have not been written by one person which clearly indicates that different persons appeared in two occasions attracting the phenomena of impersonation. Further, the face photo of above named candidates on admit card of CBT examination and PET examination is mismatching, which also tentamounts that different candidate appeared in different tiers i.e., CBT & PET of examination in the case of above named candidate attracting the phenomenon of impersonation. Accordingly, the members of the committee, unanimously & conclusively opined that above named candidate impersonated in the examination and needs to be debarred as per the practice of this board under Zero Tolerance Policy towards any misconduct by any candidates or any person appearing the examination conducted by this board.

And whereas, the recommendation of the above referred committee is placed before the Chairperson of this Board, who in turn, after careful examination of relevant record accepted the recommendation of the above referred committee and accordingly, decided that above named candidate Mr. Manish Rana S/o Mr. Bhim Singh having Date of Birth : 23.07.1996 r/o H. No. 348, Mukhmelpur, Delhi, who appeared in the examination of Post Code 86/17, Warder, Delhi Prison Department under roll No. 2890094262 / 112504001967 be debarred for lifetime w.e.f 18.06.2019 from appearing in any examination conducted / to be conducted by the DSSSB. Further the candidature of above named candidate Mr. Manish Rana will be deemed cancelled if he has appeared in any exam conducted by DSSSB prior to above date.
