ORDER

Whereas, Mr. Parveen Dabas s/o Mr. Virender Dabas, DoB : 07.12.1995 r/o H. No. 58, Ganga Tolly Road, VPO – Pooth Khurd, Delhi, who appeared in the examination of Post Code 86/17, Warder, Delhi Prison Department under roll No. 2890042691 / 12350400957 was debarred vide order No. F.55(155)/Exam/DSSSB/2019/Pt. File/344-54 dated 16.07.2020 from any examination conducted / to be conducted by the DSSSB for life time w.e.f 18.06.2019.

And whereas, said Mr. Parveen Dabas challenged the abovesaid debarment order dated 16.07.2020 before the Honb'le Central Administrative Tribunal, New Delhi vide O.A. No. 3775 / 2024 titled as "Parveen Dabas Vs. DSSSB and Ors."

And whereas, the Honb'le Central Administrative Tribunal, New Delhi vide order dated 18.07.2020 decided the outcome of case having operative part of the order as under :-

"7. Considering the above and following the decision of the Hon'ble High Court, we are of the opinion that the O.A. can be disposed of with direction to the respondents to issue proper show cause notice to the applicant giving him time to respond to the same.

8. Needless to say, the impugned debarment order dated 16.07.2020 is quashed. Let the DSSSB complete this exercise within a period of 3 months. In the meantime, while the decision on his alleged misconduct is still pending, the applicant shall be at liberty to apply and participate in any of the recruitment examination conducted by DSSSB for which he is eligible.

In view of the above, the Original Application is disposed of.

No costs."

And, whereas a Show cause Notice No. F.1(375)/CC-II/DSSSB/2019/574 – 576 dated 13.08.2025 was issued to above named candidate Mr. Parveen Dabas on undermentioned ground with the direction to submit his written explanation within 15 days of receipt of above said show cause notice, as to why appropriate action should not be taken against him as per rule

"The still photograph obtained from EdCIL matches with the photograph of 2nd page of Admit Card of Written Examination whereas all other photographs available in dossier matches with the 2nd page of Admit Card of PET Examination. It is therefore evident that the candidate appeared in PET whereas his impersonator appeared in written examination."

And whereas above named candidate Mr. Parveen Dabas submitted written reply on 22.09.2025 stating that allegation of impersonation are not tenable. The main contents of reply of show cause notice are as under :-

"1. Regarding the allegation of impersonation:

It is submitted that I myself had appeared in both the Written Examination and the PET Examination. The allegation that an impersonator appeared in the Written Examination on my behalf is factually incorrect, baseless, and legally untenable. In the show cause notice, other than a bald assertion that the photos don't match, no details as to extent of match/mismatch, the technology used or the methodology has been stated. Neither have any photos been taken from me

to conduct a match. Furthermore, the photos were not sent to FSL, Rohini / CFSL for analysis through digital forensics and therefore the alleged mismatch is without any legal or scientific basis.

2. Procedure of verification by Invigilator :

At the time of Written Examination, the thumb impression of each candidate, including myself, was duly taken by the invigilator on the admit card. Further, I was directed to sign in the presence of the invigilator on the admit card. I duly complied with this procedure. After verifying the thumb impression and the signature of each candidate, the invigilator himself affixed his signature on the admit card as a conclusive proof of correct verification.

3. Discrepancy in photographs :

Any alleged mismatch of photographs between the Written Examination admit card and the PET admit card is not attributable to me, and I have no role to play in such discrepancies which might have arisen due to technical errors. In the show cause notice, other than a bald assertion that the photos don't match, no details as to extent of match / mismatch, the technology used or the methodology has been stated. Neither have any photos been taken from me to conduct a match. It is humbly submitted that the invigilator's verification of thumb impression and signature during the examination carries greater evidentiary value than mere alleged photographic mismatch.

4. Past action of cancellation and debarment :

It is further submitted that the earlier debarment order dated 16.07.2020 and cancellation of candidature dated 24.02.2020 were already set aside by the Hon'ble Tribunal vide order dated 18.07.2025. The present proceedings are only in the nature of a fresh opportunity of hearings. Therefore, in light of the above facts, the allegation of impersonation is not tenable in law.

Looking at the marks scored for the post code 86/17 are 101/200 that are not so extraordinary or suspicious that an impersonator or someone who is using unfair means will score so low.

Sir, I humbly submit that I am a meritorious candidate and I have subsequently also cleared various written examinations, for the post of Peon / Orderly in District Court, examination for the post of HEAD CONSTABLE conducted in SSC in Delhi Police etc. Hence I had no reason to not appear in the exam myself.

I am attaching some documents (pdf. screenshots of result or other facts) that determines my credibility that I have always been a meritorious candidate."

And whereas the case of above named candidate Mr. Praveen Dabas was placed before the committee constituted vide order No. F.4(520)/P&P-II/DSSSB/2023/587 dated 06.06.2023. The committee examined his case on 08.10.2025 and decided to refer the case for forensic examination.

And whereas, the forensic report of FSL, New Delhi concluded that signature of the candidate on two occasions i.e., the day of Written Examination & PET Examination have not been written by one person.

And whereas, the above forensic report and related records of above named candidate Mr. Parveen Dabas is again placed before the above referred committee. The committee after examination of related records arrived at conclusion that signature of the candidate in two occasions i.e., on the day of his CBT Examination & PET Examination are concluded by the forensic expert that they have not been written by one person which clearly indicates that different persons appeared in two occasions attracting the phenomena of impersonation. Further, the face photo of above named candidates on admit card of CBT examination and PET examination is mismatching, which also tentamounts that different candidate appeared in different tiers i.e., CBT & PET of examination in the case of above named candidate attracting the phenomenon of impersonation. Accordingly, the members of the committee, unanimously & conclusively opined that above named candidate impersonated in the examination and needs to be debarred as per the practice of this board under Zero Tolerance Policy towards any misconduct by any candidates or any person appearing the examination conducted by this board.

And whereas, the recommendation of the above referred committee is placed before the Chairperson of this Board, who in turn, after careful examination of relevant record accepted the recommendation of the above referred committee and accordingly, decided that above named candidate Mr. Praveen Dabas s/o Mr. Virender Dabas, DoB : 07.12.1995 r/o H. No. 58, Ganga Tolly Road, VPO – Pooth Khurd, Delhi, who appeared in the examination of Post Code 86/17, Warder, Delhi Prison Department under roll No. 2890042691 / 12350400957 be debarred for lifetime w.e.f 18.06.2019 from appearing in any examination conducted / to be conducted by the DSSSB. Further the candidature of above named candidate Mr. Parveen Dabas will be deemed cancelled if he has appeared in any exam conducted by DSSSB prior to above date.
