SUPPLEMENTARY RESULT NOTICE NO: 808 RADIO TELEPHONE OPERATOR, POST CODE-72/14 IN DELHI FIRE SERVICE

The DSSSB vide its advertisement No. 01/14 dated 12/12/2014 had advertised 55 {UR-24, OBC-22, SC-02, ST-07} for the post of Radio Telephone Operator. Post Code-72/14 in Delhi Fire Service. Further, vide addendum dated 01.11.2019, the notified vacancies had been revised as 67 vacancies (UR-31, OBC-22, SC-07, ST-07). Tier-I online examination was held on 05.11.2019.

- On the basis of marks secured in the written examination and after preliminary scrutiny as per the provisions of the statutory Recruitment Rules for the post and the terms and condition of the advertisement, 49 Candidates (UR-23, OBC-17, SC-04, ST-05) were provisionally selected for the post of Radio Telephone Operator, Post Code-72/14 in Delhi Fire Service vide Result Notice No. 663 dated 07.09.2020. The candidature of 07 candidates were kept pending for want of deficient documents in the e-dossier. These candidates were given 10 days, 1st opportunity to upload the deficient / requisite documents in the e-dossier w.e.f. 21/09/2020 to 30/09/2020. Further, 11 vacancies were also kept pending for those candidates who failed to upload their e-dossier due to imposition of lockdown in the country. Such candidates were given an extraordinary opportunity vide notice no. 665 dated 07.09.2020 to upload their documents in the e-dossier w.e.f. 10.09.2020 to 19.09.2020. Therefore, 12 candidates (UR-06, OBC-03, SC-02, ST-01) were provisionally nominated vide Supplementary Result Notice No. 715 dated 19.11.2020 and 03 candidates (UR-02, SC-01) were provisionally nominated vide Supplementary Result Notice No. 740 dated 31.12.2020. Further, 03 candidates (OBC-02, ST-01) were provisionally nominated vide Supplementary Result Notice No. 747 dated 02.02.2021.
- 3. Further, the User Department i.e. Delhi Fire Service vide letters dated 22.03.2021 & 28.5.2021 has returned 12 dossiers (UR-07, OBC-01, SC-02, ST-02) of the candidates who failed to join their duties in the User Department, after cancellation of their candidature and requested to provide substitute candidate from the waiting panel. As the waiting panel for the post code-72/14 is valid upto 06.09.2021, the candidates from waiting panel have been considered for nomination.
- 4. Accordingly, in continuation of Result Notice No. 663 dated 07.09.2020, Supplementary Result Notice No. 715 dated 19.11.2020, Supplementary Result Notice No. 740 dated 31.12.2020 & Supplementary Result Notice no. 747 dated 02.02.2021, the candidates, as detailed below, are also provisionally selected on the basis of online examination of Tier-1 held on 05/11/2019 and having been found provisionally eligible as per documents uploaded in support of educational qualification, age etc in accordance with advertisement No.01/14 and RRs for the post of Radio Telephone Operator. Post Code-72/14 in Delhi Fire Service, subject to their fulfilling all other conditions of eligibility and also correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application form and e-dossier:-

- 4.* The candidate bearing Roll No. 11130700042 above has degree in B.Tech (Electronics & Communications Engineering). The user department is requested to thoroughly verify the eligibility of the candidates with regard to essential qualification as per RRs before issuance of any offer of appointment. The user department is further requested that if the candidate found not eligible, his/her dossier may be returned after cancellation of his/her candidature.
- 5. The essential Physical Standard for Male & Female has been given as under:-

(For Gents): -

Height: 165 cms (relaxable for hilly area persons by 5 cms)

Weight: 50 Kgs,

Chest: 86.5 cms (Expanded)

Eye sight 6/6.

For Ladies : -

Height -155 cms. (relaxable for hilly area persons by 5 cms),

Weight -45 Kgs, Eye sight- 6/6.

- 6. The User Department i.e. Delhi Fire Service, GNCTD is requested to check physical measurement/eye sight test of all the provisionally nominated candidates at their own level before issuing of offer of appointment. If any candidate found not eligible with regard to Physical Standard, his/her e-dossier may be returned after cancellation of his/her candidature.
- 7. The selection of the above 12 candidates shall further be subject to genuineness of the documents on the basis of which they have claimed to have fulfilled all the eligibility

- conditions as prescribed in the RRs and terms and conditions of advertisement inviting applications and subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signatures/handwriting etc. on the application form, admission certificate etc. The candidature of the above candidates are liable to be cancelled by the User Department also, in case the candidates are found not to be fulfilling the terms & conditions of the advertisement inviting applications for the said post code. The Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letter to the candidates after being satisfied about their eligibility as laid down in the recruitment rules and after verification of the correctness of the information furnished in the application form and the documents related to Educational Qualification, Age and other essential certificates.
- 8. The user department shall also check the eligibility of the reservation benefit, if any. Further, if applicable, the User Department shall verify the genuineness of the Caste Certificates furnished by the candidate prior to issuing offer of appointment to the candidate. The Competent Authority of the user department shall arrange to verify the correctness of the information/documents as furnished in the e-dossier vis-à-vis the original documents. User Department is requested to ascertain the scrutiny /correctness of the same at their own level before issuing the offer of appointment to the provisionally selected candidates. Further, the appointing authority shall verify and satisfy itself about the authenticity of documents/certificates and essential qualification for the post before finally appointing the candidate. The User Department is also requested to rectify/correct, in case, any minor/clerical error/deficiency noticed in the documents of the candidate at their own level.
- 9. It is stated that the User Department shall verify the genuineness of the caste certificate furnished by the candidate in the light of Notification No. 36012/22-93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/1993 issued by DOPT and other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time by the Competent Authority prior to issuance of offer of appointment to the candidate. It is further stated that, prior to appointment, the User Department must satisfy, itself, that the above candidates are fulfilling the necessary criteria as prescribed for entitlement of OBC (Delhi) certificate as specified in various Orders/Guidelines/Circulars including order dated 07/03/2017 issued by Revenue Department, GNCTD after thorough verification of caste certificate.
- 10. The User Department shall also get the SC/ST/OBC/PH/ExSM/etc. certificates verified from the Issuing authority. Further, if applicable, User Department shall also verify the genuineness of the caste certificates furnished by the candidates prior to issuing offer of appointment to the candidates. In case of the OBC candidates, it may also be verified that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer of the schedule of Govt. of India, DoPT O.M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08.09.1993, O.M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 09.03.2004 and 14.10.2009 and O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res) dated 27.05.2013 & 13.09.2017.
- 11. The Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letters to the candidates after being satisfied about his eligibility as laid down in the recruitment rules and after verification of the correctness of the information/documents as furnished in the application form and e-dossier vis-à-vis the original documents related to Educational Qualification, Age and other essential Certificates as per instructions issued by Govt. of India in this regard vide MHA O.M. No. 2/29/54-RPS, 19-11-54.
- 12. The user department shall ensure that the appointment made is in conformity with DoPT guidelines and instructions of Govt. issued from time to time.

- 13. The result process for the above post code stands closed in all respect.
- 14. A waiting panel has been prepared which will be valid for a period of one year from the date of declaration of result i.e. upto 06/09/2021 as per earlier Result Notice No. 663 dated 07.09.2020.
- 15. Mere inclusion of name of candidate in the result notice does not confer any right upon the candidate over the post unless the appointing authority is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respect for appointment to the Post.
- 16. The category wise marks obtained by the last selected candidates have been given as under:-
