JUNIOR STENOGRAPHER (ENGLISH) IN NDMC UNDER POSTCODE 47/2012

The DSSSB vide its advertisement No. 02/2012 with closing date 15.6.2012, had advertised 33 vacancies (16 UR, 17 OBC including 01 PH) for the post of Junior Stenographer (Eng) in NDMC under Post code 47/2012. Board conducted Tier-I written examination for selection to the post along with similar postcodes on 11.06.2017. Board had declared marks of Tier-I written examination of the candidates of the post of Stenographer Grade III in NDMC under Post code 47/2012 vide notice number 548 dated 06.10.2017.

- 2. Based on the performance in the one tier examination, 157 candidates were shortlisted for appearing in Shorthand and Typewriting Skill Test vide notice number 562 dated 25.10.2017. The skill test result for shorthand and typewriting was conducted w.e.f. 08.02.2017 to 11.02.2018, wherein 110 candidates have appeared. The result status of these candidates are being uploaded in OARS module, concerned candidates can check their status by logging into their account in OARs module on www.dsssb online.nic.in.
- 3. The Board has adopted the criteria for evaluation of the skill test and in the skill test considered upto 7% mistakes for UR category and upto 10 % mistakes for all reserved category candidates, on the pattern of SSC, as qualified in the shorthand skill test with a speed of 80 w.p.m.
- 4. As per RRs for the post the candidate was to qualify the 30 w.p.m. in English typing.
- 5. On basis of above parameters out of 110 candidates who appeared for Shorthand skill test and Typewriting skill test, only 47 candidates have qualified the both Shorthand skill test and Typewriting skill test.

6. Based on the qualifying both Shorthand skill test and Typewriting skill test following 5 candidates having roll numbers are provisionally allowed to upload e-dossiers subject to correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms.

- 8. Kindly note that the e-dossier link will be activated to only those candidates who have qualified both Shorthand skill test and Typewriting skill test.
- 9. All the candidates who have been shortlisted MUST upload their all requisite/applicable documents in the said link.
- 10. The e-dossier link shall be active from 26.7.2018 to 9.8.2018.
- 11. As Board has conducted the combined examination for the post of Junior Stenographer (English) in NDMC under postcode 47/12; for the post of Stenographer (Grade III) in MAIDS under postcode 152/14 and for the post of Stenographer (Grade III) in Services Department under postcode 211/14, the common candidate may give their preference of posts in the e-dossier.
- 12. While every care has been taken in preparing the list of shortlisted candidates, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions if any, detected at any stage.

- 13. In case of non-compliance of the above instructions regarding uploading the e-dossier, the candidature of the candidate is liable to be cancelled /rejected.
