### ORDER

**SUB: - Compliance of order dated 25/01/2023 passed by the Ld. CAT in OA No. 234/2023 in the matter of "Ms. Samia Iqbal vs. GNCTD & Ors."**

This order shall dispose of the representation of the applicant dated 19.05.2022, 10.08.2022, and 08.09.2022 in compliance of the order passed by Ld. CAT in OA No. 234/2023 dated 25/01/2023 wherein the court has directed,

*"In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the applicant, the respondents/ competent authority is hereby directed to dispose of the pending representations dated 19.05.2022, 10.08.2022 and 08.09.2022 of the applicant by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a span of six weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. A copy of the speaking order so passed be given to the applicant. With these directions, the OA stands disposed of."*

Whereas that the applicant, Ms. Samia Iqbal (Roll No. 113905300012) submitted representations dated 19.05.2022, 10.08.2022, and 08.09.2022 with the plea to consider her candidature for the post of TGT (Urdu), Female, Post Code 53/21. In representation dated 19.05.2022 she stated that she has been rejected as according to the board she has studied Urdu only one year during the graduation whereas she claimed that she has studied Urdu subject two years during her graduation and hence not to reject her candidature. She submitted similar representation on 10.08.2022 and 08.09.2022. She submitted that she brought a certificate for two years of study of Urdu from Zakir Hussain, Delhi College. She further stated that she has submitted application in Delhi University for such certificate as of Zakir Hussain College but it would take a month or two and did not submit.

Whereas the Board vide advertisement No. 03/2021 dated 27.05.2021 advertised 571 vacancies (UR-262, EWS-20, OBC-151, SC-93, ST-45, PH/OH-12, PH/VH-14) for the post of TGT (Urdu) Female, Post Code-53/21 in Directorate of Education. Online written examination for the post of TGT (Urdu) Female Post Code-53/21 was held on 08.09.2021.

As per Recruitment Rules, and advertisement the Essential Qualification for the post of TGT (Urdu), Female, Post Code-53/21 has been prescribed/mentioned is as:-

(i) B.A. (Honours) in one of the Modern Indian Language (MIL) concerned or B.A. with MIL concerned as one of the elective subjects from a recognized University having 45% marks in aggregate with one additional language or one school subject at degree level.

OR

Equivalent oriental degree in MIL concerned from a recognized University having 45% marks in aggregate.

OR

(For appointment as Hindi Teachers only) Sahitya Rattan of Hindi Sahitya Sammelan Prayag having secure at least 45% marks in aggregate with English in Matriculation.

Provided further that the requirement as to the minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate shall be relaxable in the case of (a) candidates who possess a post Graduate Qualification in MIL concerned from a recognized University (b) candidates belonging to SC/ST (c) Physically handicapped candidates.

- (ii) Degree/ diploma in Teaching.
- (iii) Knowledge of Hindi is essential
- (iv) Should have qualified CTET from CBSE.

**Note: - "The candidate should have studied the subject concerned as mentioned in the RR's for at least 02 years during the Graduation course. The elective word may also include main subject as practiced in different Universities.**

Whereas, based on the marks secured in examination and after preliminary scrutiny as per the provisions of the statutory recruitment rules, a total of 51 candidates (UR-51 incl. 01 PH/VH, EWS- Nil, OBC-13, SC-02, ST-01) were provisionally nominated for the post of TGT (Urdu) Female, Post Code 53/21 vide Main Result Notice No. 864 dated 17/05.2022.

Whereas, the applicant, Ms. Samia Iqbal applied for the post of 53/21 TGT (Urdu)-Female under OBC category. She was allotted Roll No. 113905300012 and secured 96.21 marks against cut off marks 73.48 in the examination and accordingly she was shortlisted for uploading of e-dossier w.e.f. 24.12.2021 to 07.01.2022 under OBC category.

That on scrutiny of the documents in the e-dossier uploaded by the candidate, it was found that she uploaded degree in **B.A. (Honors) in History subject & 3<sup>rd</sup> year marks sheet dated 16.06.2014** in the e-dossier alongwith other documents.

But as per Part -I/ First year mark sheet she has studied

- a) History of India upto A.D 750
- b) SOC.Formation & Cult. Patterns of Ancient & Medieval World
- c) English (Language)
- d) Reading Gandhi
- e) Urdu -Higher (Qualifying) But the marks of Urdu Higher Qualifying have not been considered in the result.

In Part -II /Second Year

- a) History of India (750 A.D -1550 A.D
- a) The Rise of Modern West
- b) History of the USA
- c) Urdu- Urdu Literature



d) Pol. Science Citizenship

In Part -III /Third Year of BA (Honours) (History)

- a) History of India (1550-1750)
- b) History of India (1750-1950)
- c) History of China and Japan (1840-1949)
- d) History of Modern Europe (including Britain, 1780-1939)

Total marks scored in Graduation by the candidate are as under:-

In the result, the marks of Urdu Literature in second year has been considered and hence the Urdu subject has been studied only in one year as main subject.

The Board issued notice as first opportunity dated 09.03.2022 to upload the requisite documents/deficiency memo dated 15.03.2022 to 24.03.2022 stating the remarks to Ms. Samia Iqbal, the candidate, "that the candidate has done BA (History) Hon. whereas as per RRs BA degree with Urdu as an elective/main subject required. The candidate is directed to upload BA (Hon.) in Urdu or BA with Urdu as one of the elective subject having 45% marks in aggregate". She did not upload any reply.

The Board issued another notice as second and final opportunity dated 07.04.2022 to upload the requisite document from 11.04.2022 to 15.04.2022 stating the same remarks. She did not submit any reply or any document.

Hence, a Rejection Notice No. 865 was issued on 17.05.2022 stating, "BA degree in History (Honors), the candidate has studied Urdu subject in one year in her graduation whereas as per RRs, the candidate must have studied subject concerned atleast 02 years during the graduation course. She was given two opportunities w.e.f. 15.03.2022 to 24.03.2022 and 11.04.2022 to 15.04.2022 but failed to upload sufficient reply in the e-dossier. Hence, not eligible".

Later she submitted aforementioned representation dated 19.05.2022, 10.08.2022 and 08.09.2022.

After perusal of record and consideration of plea given by the representations it has been found that

1. As per mark sheet uploaded by her, it was mentioned in mark sheet that she has qualified one paper i.e., Urdu Higher (Qualifying) in First Year. However, the marks are not added in total marks in the marks sheet in any year of graduation whereas she has studied Urdu in 2<sup>nd</sup> Year as Urdu Literature (Discipline Centered Concurrent Course) whose marks are added in the result. This shows that the

candidate has studied Urdu as a main subject/Elective for one year and not in two years which violates the conditions of RRs.

2. She has submitted a certificate from Zakir Hussain College issued on 05.09.2022 stating

*"This is to certify that Samia Iqbal D/o Mr. Iqbal Ahmed was a bonafide student regular mode of the college during the academic year 2010-2013 studying in B.A (Hons.) History course. She completed her graduation in 2013 bearing Examination Roll No. 5042716 and secured 645/1100 marks with Second Division. It is further certified that Samia Iqbal studied Urdu subject in regular mode in Part -1 and Part -2 as per the following details:*

The said certificate has been prepared and submitted after the rejection notice. Moreover, as per certificate, the candidate has studied Urdu only and not as the main/elective subject which is required in the RRs and advertisement. Hence, the said certificate still does not make the representations eligible as per RRs and advertisement.

- 3 The prescribed essential qualification for the said post is – BA Honours in one of the MIL or BA with MIL concerned as one of the subject from a recognized university having 45% marks in aggregate with one additional language or one school subject at degree level.

The applicant has passed BA (Honours) History and not the required qualification i.e., BA Honours in one of the MIL. Further, the applicant has studied Urdu language as **main subject/elective** in second year only and not the required essential qualification for two year graduation with MIL concerned as one of the subject in the University.

The contention is that the candidate is claiming that she had studied Urdu for two years on the basis of marksheets and certificate of her BA (Hon.) History from college whereas none of the record shows that she has studied Urdu as elective/main subject for two year.

Hence, the candidate did not possess the requisite qualification as per RRs vis-à-vis essential qualifications provided by the User Department and as per terms and conditions of the advertisement. Therefore, the candidature of the candidate



Ms. Samia Iqbal (Roll No. 113905300012) was rightly rejected vide Rejection Notice No. 865 dated 17.05.2022 for not fulfilling the eligibility criteria of RRs for the post of TGT (Urdu), Female under Post Code-53/21.

Moreover, the representation dated 19.05.2022, 10.08.2022, and 08.09.2022 filed by Ms. Samia Iqbal (Roll no. 113905300012) is examined and not found admissible in view of facts mentioned above, hence **Rejected**.
