## ORDER

On scrutiny of biometric reports taken during CBT and Driving Skill Test for Post Code 18/19 (Fire Operator, Delhi Fire Service) by DSSSB, it has been found that Mr. Vijay Kumar S/o Sh. Chander Bhan, whose details are mentioned in table below, was found indulging in unfair means, malpractices and criminal activity like Cheating, Impersonation, Forgery, Conspiracy etc. during the above said post code exam.

Chander Bhan	4660057718/ 112500501857 /7030002547		The signature of the applicant on 2nd page of admit card of the day of PET Examination dated 15.02.2020, CBT examination dated 22.04.2021 & driving skill test dated 15.07.2022 are not same. The photo of candidate taken by EdCIL on the day of CBT examination dated 22.04.2021 & driving skill test dated 15.07.2022 seems to be mismatching with each other. The biometric report on occasions of CBT & Driving skill test provided by the EdCIL has remarks as "Not matched". The handwriting proforma dt. 22.04.2021 & 15.07.2022 recorded on the day of CBT Exam & driving skill test respectively are not matching with each other.  Thus a case of impersonation.

Further, it is not out of place to mention here that the Candidates appearing in various examinations being conducted by the DSSSB have repeatedly been warned not to resort to any unfair means/ malpractices and further, that:

"Any attempt to commit or abet, as the case may be all or any of the acts such as (i) Impersonating, and (ii) Procuring impersonation by any person, may in addition to render himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:"

- a) To be disqualified by the Board from the examination for which he/ she is a candidate as also from any other examination/selection of the Board in which he/ she might have appeared by the final result/ selection has not been declared/ made and or
- b) To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period from any examination held or selection made by them and or,
- c) To take disciplinary action if he/she is already in service under Government and or,
- d) To take any other legal action'

Further, attention is drawn to the Point No.-11 of the "General Instruction" dated 12.05.2022 for candidates for the said post code which is reproduced as under:-

"If any candidate is found using any unfair means, conspiracy, cheating, fraud, forgery, impersonation or any unlawful act he will be debarred from all examinations of DSSSB and necessary legal action will be initiated."

Thus, it is clear that the candidate had arranged to have another person taking examinations in place of him/her. Thus, the candidate and the impersonator have indulged in the following activities amounting to impersonation:

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i) Appearing for examination for another candidate or arranging to have another person taken an examination for the candidate.

ii) Allowing/Making somebody else to write answers on candidate's behalf

- iii) Helping or receiving help from other candidates to impersonate.
- iv) Signing/ getting signed the attendance sheet and other examination documents on somebody else's behalf either partially or completely.
- v) Providing admit card to another person to enable him to appear on

Further, this candidate have also indulged in the act of FORGERY and UNLAWFUL ACT by altering the identity proof of candidates, admit cards etc, and produced these documents to the examination conducting functionaries with the intent to defraud, as the documents produced are materially different from the records

Therefore, it is evident that the candidate along with impersonator was actively involved in the crime related to impersonation, cheating, forgery, connivance and conspiracy as specified in Indian Penal Code.

In view of above facts and circumstances, the DSSSB has come to the conclusion that, prima facie, a case of impersonation, cheating, forgery, connivance and conspiracy is made out against the candidates.

The DSSSB adheres to ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TOWARDS ANY MISCONDUCT by any candidate or any persons. Therefore, in view the above Mr. Vijay Kumar S/o Sh. Chander Bhan having Date of Birth: 10/08/1993 bearing Roll No.: 4660057718/112500501857/7030002547 of Post Code 18/19 is hereby debarred from any examination conducted/to be conducted by the DSSSB for lifetime w.e.f 15.02.2020. Further the candidature of Mr. Vijay Kumar will be deemed cancelled if he has appeared in any exam conducted by DSSSB prior to above
