ORDER

The biometric verification of candidate Mr. Sanjeev Kumar during his skill test on 05.06.2022 did not match with biometric records taken during online CBT exam on Post Code 13/20 JUNIOR CLERK in DELHI TRANSPORT for CORPORATION by DSSSB. Thus, Mr. Sanjeev Kumar, whose details are mentioned in table below, was found indulging in unfair means, malpractices and criminal activity like Cheating, Impersonation, Forgery, Conspiracy etc. during the above said post code exam.

The Biometric Photograph taken during Computer Based Test (CBT) at iON Digital Zone, iDZ 1, Mathura Road on 13.11.2021 and Biometric done during Skill Test at Bhai Parmanand Institute of Business Studies on 05.06.2022 did not match. The same was also observed by the Observer at the time of Skill Test. The same report has also been received from the agency that performed Biometric verification. Committee recommended to debar the candidate. Thus it is a case of impersonation.

Further, it is not out of place to mention here that the Candidates appearing in various examinations being conducted by the DSSSB have repeatedly been warned not to resort to any unfair means/ malpractices and further, that:

"Any attempt to commit or abet, as the case may be all or any of the acts such as (i) Impersonating, and (ii) Procuring impersonation by any person, may in addition to render himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable:"

- To be disqualified by the Board from the examination for which he/ she is a candidate as also from any other examination/selection of the Board in which he/ she might have appeared by the final result/ selection has not been declared/ made and or
- b) To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period from any examination held or selection made by them and or,
- c) To take disciplinary action if he/she is already in service under Government and or,
- d) To take any other legal action'

Further, attention is drawn to the point 23 of the "General Instruction" dated 08.04.2022 for candidates for the said post code which is reproduced as under:-

"If any candidate is found using any unfair means or impersonation he/she will be debarred from all examination of DSSSB and/or necessary legal action be initiated."

Thus, it is clear that the candidate had arranged to have another person taking examinations in place of him/her. Thus, the candidate and the impersonator have indulged in the following activities amounting to impersonation:

- i) Appearing for examination for another candidate or arranging to have another person taken an examination for the candidate.
- ii) Allowing/Making somebody else to write answers on candidate's behalf during examination.
- iii) Helping or receiving help from other candidates to impersonate.
- iv) Signing/ getting signed the attendance sheet and other examination documents on somebody else's behalf either partially or completely.
- v) Providing admit card to another person to enable him to appear on behalf of the candidate.

Further, this candidate have also indulged in the act of **FORGERY and UNLAWFUL ACT** by altering the identity proof of candidates, admit cards etc, and produced these documents to the examination conducting functionaries with the intent to defraud, as the documents produced are materially different from the records available with the DSSSB.

Therefore, it is evident that the candidate along with impersonator was actively involved in the **crime related to impersonation**, **cheating**, **forgery**, **connivance and conspiracy** as specified in Indian Penal Code.

In view of above facts and circumstances, the DSSSB has come to the conclusion that, prima facie, a case of impersonation, cheating, forgery, connivance and conspiracy is made out against the candidates.

The DSSSB adheres to **ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TOWARDS ANY MISCONDUCT** by any candidate or any persons. Therefore, in view the above **Mr. Sanjeev Kumar** S/o Sh. Raghunath Prasad Singh having Date of Birth: **25/02/1993** bearing Roll No.: 317013001553/ 6990001922 of Post Code 13/20 is hereby debarred from any examination conducted/to be conducted by the DSSSB **for lifetime w.e.f. 13.11.2021.** Further the candidature of **Mr. Sanjeev Kumar** will be deemed cancelled if he has appeared in any exam conducted by DSSSB prior to above date.
