ORDER

Whereas, Mr. Ramkesh Meena (DoB : 05.07.1991) s/o Sh. Hargovind Meena r/o Village Kalikhad, Post : Thumdi, District : Dausa (Rajasthan) had applied for the vacancy of P.G.T. (Hindi) (Male/Female), Directorate of Education, Govt. of Delhi / New Delhi Municipal Committee under post code 804/23 of advertisement No. 07/2023 dated 22.12.2023 issued by this board.

And whereas said Mr. Ramkesh Meena had filed two applications in response of above said advertisement as per detailed below :-

And whereas, said Mr. Ramkesh Meena with the intent to file two applications for the same post & advertisement had used two different mobile numbers & e-mail address as detailed below :-

And whereas, said Mr. Ramkesh Meena, with an ulterior motive to file two applications for same post and advertisement had mentioned name of his mother as "Mooli Devi Meena" in one of the application while in other application as "Mooli Devi" while his father's Name, date of birth and address remained same

And whereas, by filing two application for the same post & advertisement, said Mr. Ramkesh Meena was allotted two different roll No's and admit cards, whose examinations were scheduled on different days, and said Mr. Ramkesh Meena appeared in examination against these two different roll numbers for competing for one and same post, as per detailed below :-

And whereas, it is indicated in the above stated advertisement No. 07/2023 that if an applicant submits multiple registrations and appears in the examination (at any stage) more than once, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he/she will be debarred from the examinations of the Board.

And whereas, point No. 9(f) / 9(g) of "Important instructions to candidates" has clearly mentioned that only one online registration is allowed to be submitted by a candidate. Therefore, candidates must exercise due diligence at the time of filling their online Registration Forms. In case, more than one Registration of a candidate is detected, all such registrations will be rejected and his/her candidature for the examination will be cancelled. If a candidate submits multiple registrations and appears in the examination (at any stage) more than once, his/her candidature will be cancelled and he will be debarred from the examinations of the Board.

And whereas, above named candidate Mr. Ramkesh Meena violated the abovesaid instructions and needs to be dealt accordingly for the said misconduct as per the advertisement

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published in this regard, as this board adheres to zero tolerance policy towards any misconduct by any candidate or any persons appearing in examination conducted by DSSSB.

And whereas, a show cause notice dated 26.05.2026 was issued to said Mr. Ramkesh Meena directing to submit his detailed explanation in writing within fifteen days of receipt of said show cause notice as to why he filed two various applications for the same post / advertisement as well as why he appeared in examination twice for the same post and advertisement, further explaining the reasons as to why his case of misconduct may not be considered for strict punitive action of debarment from appearing in forthcoming examination as well as registration of FIR against him with the concerned law enforcement agencies for his above cited ill acts.

And whereas, said Sh. Ramkesh Meena submitted his written explanation mentioning following point :_

- (i) Commission of above stated error is due to his ignorance of fact as he belongs to rural background.
- (ii) Being no knowledge of recruitment rules and procedure, he appeared in exam twice in different shifts.
- (iii) Due to server error, his first registration was wrong and he created second registration.

And whereas, the reply of above named candidate is perused minutely and following conclusions are drawn based on available documents and record :-

- (i) Commission of above stated error due to his ignorance of fact that he belongs to rural background cannot be accepted as all such facts are mentioned in the advertisement under point No. 9(f) / 9(g) of "Important instructions to candidates". It is incumbent upon all candidates that all candidates should read the "Important instructions to candidates" before filling the application form. Moreover, the candidate is qualified (post graduate) with a degree of Education, hence such type of reply cannot be accepted from a candidate who is going to compete for the post of a teacher, whose duty is generally to light the lamps of knowledge in the society for advancement and development of upcoming generation.
- (ii) The server does not modifies any entry made by candidates. Further, the candidate has not explained in his reply why he used two different mobile number and e-mail address during submission of two applications. Moreover, he utilized both the admit cards received on these two different e-mails having different roll No. and shift of examination. Using of two different mobile number and two different email address for creating two applications clearly proves his malafide intention.
- (iii) It has also brought on record that similar type of practice is adopted by the above named candidate in post code 805/24, TGT (Social Science) of Advertisement No. 02/2024 where he submitted two applications having ID 12597597 & 13312992 for the same post & got two roll numbers 248051209009699 & 248051209011951, and appeared in examination twice on 08.11.2025, Shift 2 & 10.11.2025, Shift 1 at Adarsh Pariksha Kendra Center A, Sector 64, Noida.
- (iv) He also applied for post code 807/24, TGT (Hindi) of Advertisement No. 02/2024 where he submitted two applications having ID 12796109 & 13310395 for the same post & got two roll numbers 248071202000096 & 248071202004277, and appeared in examination twice on 17.08.2025, Shift 1 & 17.08.2025, Shift 3 at Adarsh Pariksha Kendra Center A, Sector 64, Noida.



And whereas, based on available record and analysis of reply of candidate, the Competent Authority is of the view that act of the candidate is deliberate, malafide & intentional one and needs to be dealt accordingly for said misconduct as this board adheres to **ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TOWARDS ANY MISCONDUCT** by any candidate or any persons appearing in examination conducted by DSSSB. Therefore, in view the above, Mr. Ramkesh Meena (DoB : 05.07.1991) s/o Sh. Hargovind Meena r/o Village Kalikhad, Post : Thumdi, District : Dausa (Rajasthan) bearing above stated Roll No's. is hereby debarred from appearing in any examination conducted / to be conducted by the DSSSB for **lifetime from the date of filing of application for above post code**. Further, his candidature will be deemed cancelled if he had appeared in any exam conducted by DSSSB prior to above date.

This issues with the prior approval of the Chairman, DSSSB.
