## RESULT NOTICE NO. 237 DRIVER (POST CODE NO. 65/09) DELHI TRANSPORT CORPORATION, GOVT. OF NCT OF DELHI

In compliance of order's of Ld. CAT dated (02.12.2013 in CP No. 356/2013) 14.12.2012 as passed in OA No. 434/2012 titled as Sheespal V/S GNCTD & Ors. The operative part of its order is reproduced hereunder: 14.12.2012

"Today, when the matter was taken up for consideration, the learned counsel for the parties have submitted that the issue raised in this OA has now been settled by the Hon'ble High court of Delhi In WP©-5390/2012 (Deepak Kumar and Ors. Vs. District and Sessions Judge, Delhi and Ors.) and connected cases on 12.09.2012.

"In view of the above position, this OA is allowed. Consequently, we declare that the applicant is qualified for the post of Driver and shall be deemed to have been selected for the aforesaid post. We also direct the respondents to appoint him against the post of driver with all consequential benefits except back wages without any further delay, if he is otherwise found eligible. The aforesaid directions shall be complied with as early as possible but in any case within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs."

Accordingly, the candidate with following particulars has been provisionally selected to the post of Driver (DTC) in Delhi Transport Corporation, Govt, of NCT of Delhi in the Pay Scale of Rs 3200-4900 (prerevised) under post code 065/09 subject to his passing the medical examination requiring **HEIGHT**- 162 Cms. (Minimum) and VISION: - 6/6 without glasses and no color blindness and as per the medical standard for driver prescribed by D.T.C.

The selection against advertised vacancies in above post code was processed by the Board and result was declared vide result notice dated 06.12.2010 and 14.06.2011 , 26.12.2011, 17.2.2012, 30.04.2012, 4/5/2012 and 30/10/2013 as per merit drawn on the basis of Part-II examination (Descriptive) held on 14.03.2010 and 21.03.2010. The vacancies had been advertised by the Board as per requisitions of Delhi Transport Corporation, Govt, of NCT of Delhi vide advertisement No. 003/2009 with closing date of receipt of application as 02.12.2009.

Driving Skill Test Evaluation Boards as per provisions of RRs of the post, requiring the candidate to hold a valid Heavy Motor Vehicle License for at least three years, have considered candidates, who possessed valid HTV Driving License as on 03.12.2006 i.e. three years prior to the cutoff date, eligible to appear in the skill test and declared the candidates passed subject to verification of their Driving Licenses. As such, the nomination as above shall be subject to candidate's producing proof of issue/endorsement of their HTV driving license of period 03.12.2006 and prior to that date. In respect of candidates whose particulars as recorded in application form for the post varies from the particulars as indicated in the driving license, the Board nominates the candidates to the post with clear stipulation that veracity of driving license of such candidates shall be got verified from the RTO concerned, by the DTC authorities,

As per the provision of the RRs, selected candidate, who do not possess PSV Badge issued/endorsed by STA-Delhi, will have to obtain the same within 3 months of their selection and this time period could further be extended by DTC on merits. However the driver would actually start on line duty in DTC only after the required PSV badge is issued to him.

Selection of above 01 (one) candidate under SC category shall further be subject to the candidate found fulfilling the eligibility conditions as per RRs for the post up to the satisfaction of the appointing authority, for which documents as submitted with application forms and submitted at the time of driving skill test as placed in respective dossiers, shall be verified by the DTC authorities from the original ones/issuing authority and also subject to verification of genuineness of candidature of the candidate through signatures/thumb impressions, as put up by the candidate in his application form, admit cards of written as well as skill test examination and handwritten submission obtained during driving skill test. Mere inclusion of name in the result notice does not confer any right upon the candidate over the post.
