The DSSSB vide its advertisement no. 02/2012 with closing date 15/06/2012 had advertised 44 vacancies (UR-24, OBC-15 & SC-05 including PH(OH)-02)) for the Post of Section Officer (Horticulture) under post code 28/12 in MCD. Board Conducted Tier-I (T) written examination for recruitment in respect of this post on 06/10/2019.
2. The marks statement of the candidates has been uploaded on OARS Module of the Board for information of the candidates. All the candidates can view their marks by logging into their account in the OARS Module on [www.dsssonline.nic.in](http://www.dsssonline.nic.in).
3. Based on the performance in Tier-I written examination, 28 candidates as detailed below, have been provisionally shortlisted to appear in Tier-II examination subject to attaining minimum qualifying marks and correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms. The shortlisted candidates shall be called for skill test separately.

Since documents have not been called from the candidates along-with the application forms as such detailed scrutiny regarding eligibility has not been carried out, and therefore, mere inclusion of name in the list of candidates qualifying for appearing in Tier-II examination does not entitled them any right over the post.
5. As per the Board Notice dated 26/04/2013 the minimum qualifying marks in One Tier written examination for UR category candidate is 40%, for OBC candidate is 35 and for SC/ST/PH is 30%.
6. All 28 (UR-17, OBC-04 & SC-07) candidates who are qualified in Tier-I examination have been shortlisted for appearing in Tier-II examination.
7. While every care has been taken in preparing the list of shortlisted candidates, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions if any, detected at any later stage.
