Part-I : Hindi Language & Grammar : 20 Marks (20 MCQs)

The questions will be designed to assess the candidate's command over various aspects of Hindi Language and Grammar including vocabulary, sentence structure and idiomatic expressions etc. The aim is to evaluate candidate's linguistic accuracy, clarity of expression and proficiency in Hindi Language skills essential for effective translation, drafting and interpretation of legislative documents.

Part-II : English Language & Grammar : 20 Marks (20 MCQs)

The questions will be designed to assess the candidate's command over various aspects of English Language and Grammar including vocabulary usage, word power, sentence structure, sentence correction, voice, narration, idioms and phrases etc. These skills are essential for handling high quality translation and effective interpretation of legislative documents.

Part-III: Translation Aptitude : 40 Marks (40 MCQs)

The questions will be designed to assess the candidate's proficiency in accurately and precisely translating a wide range of texts, including Parliamentary Expressions, Legislative Documents, Letters, Notifications, Bills & Bulletins etc. from English to Hindi & vice-versa.

Part-IV : Legislative Terminology : 20 Marks (20 MCQs)

The questions will be designed to assess the candidate's familiarity with Legislative Vocabulary and Terminologies used in Parliament and Legislative Assemblies, ensuring accurate legislative translation.

Part-V : Constitutional and Legal Awareness : 25 Marks (25 MCQs)

The questions will be designed to assess the candidate's knowledge of key constitutional provisions and official language policy, including Preamble, Fundamental Rights, Directive Principles of State Policy, Structure and functioning of Lok Sabha, Rajya Sabha, Legislative Assemblies and Councils, Law making process, Constitutional Amendment and other important features of the Constitution and the Official Language Act and Policy.

Part-VI : Current Affairs and General Knowledge : 25 Marks (25 MCQs)

The questions will be designed to evaluate the candidate's awareness of current events, particularly major developments related to Legislation, Governance, Parliament & State Legislatures, Judiciary and Media.
