**JUNIOR PERSONAL ASSISTANT (English)  
IN DELHI TRANSCO LIMITED  
UNDER POST CODE 56/2013**

1. The DSSSB vide its advertisement number 03/2013 with closing date 18.10.2013, had advertised 12 vacancies (UR-08,OBC-03, SC-1) for the post of Junior Personal Assistant (English) in Delhi Transco Ltd. under Post code 56/2013 in the pay scale of Rs. 8500-26300/- having Grade Pay of 3100/- (Pre- revised). Board has conducted One Tier Examination (G) for recruitment to this post on 27.08.2017. Marks of 105 candidates who appeared in the examination and whose OMR sheet have been evaluated were uploaded on Board's website vide notice number 602 dated 07.02.2018.

2. Based on the performance in the one tier examination, 68 candidates were shortlisted for appearing in Shorthand and Typewriting (English) Skill Test vide notice number 602 dated 07.02.2018. Later, vide notice number 628 dated 11.04.2018 the candidature of 16200845 was rescinded. The skill for shorthand and typewriting was conducted on 15.04.2018, wherein 30 candidates have appeared. The skill test result status of these candidates were uploaded vide notice number 685 dated 10.07.2018.

3. The Board has adopted the criteria for evaluation of the skill test on the pattern of SSC and considered upto 7% mistakes for UR category and upto 10 % mistakes for all reserved category candidates, as qualified in the shorthand skill test with a speed of 80 w.p.m.

4. Based on the performance in Shorthand and Typewriting skill test 05 candidates who have qualified the both Shorthand and typewriting skill test were provisionally allowed to upload e-dossiers wef 13.07.2018 to 27.7.2018.

5. After preliminary scrutiny of the candidature of candidates as per the provisions of the statutory Recruitment Rules for the post in respect of the educational qualification and the terms and conditions of the advertisement, the following candidates are provisionally selected to the post of post of Junior Personal Assistant (English) in Delhi Transco Ltd. under Post code 56/2013.

**9.** The selection of the above **05** Candidates shall be further subject to the thorough verification of the candidature of the candidate by the User Department including the identity of the candidate. **All these selection is purely provisional subject to satisfaction of the user department that candidate is a computer literate and capable to work on MS Word & MS Excel in reference to the provisions as prescribed in the RRs for the post by the User Department. DSSSB has not undertaken veracity/scrutiny of same being being subjective in manner and technical in nature. Delhi Transco Ltd. may ensure their correctness at its own level.**

10. The candidature of the candidate is liable to be cancelled by the User Department, in case candidate is found not fulfilling all the eligibility conditions of the Recruitment Rules of the post or any other genuine reason. The decision of the User Department/appointing authority regarding the eligibility of the candidate shall be the final and binding on the candidate.

11. The User department shall check the eligibility of the reservation benefit/age relaxation, if any. Further, if applicable User Department shall



verify the genuineness of the caste certificate furnished by the candidate prior to issuing offer of appointment to the candidates.

12. The Competent Authority of the User Department shall arrange to verify the correctness of the information/ documents as furnished in the application forms vis-à-vis the original documents including the Diploma, Driving License and Experience Certification. Further, the appointing authority shall verify these documents and satisfy itself about the authenticity of documents/certificates before finally appointing the candidates.

13. Mere inclusion of the name of the candidate in the result notice does not confer any right upon the candidate over the post unless the appointing authority is satisfied after such inquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respect for appointment to the post.
