**JUNIOR PERSONAL ASSISTANT
IN DELHI TRANSCO LTD.
UNDER POST CODE 56/2013**

1. The DSSSB vide its advertisement No 03/2013 with closing date 18.10.2013, had advertised 12 vacancies (UR-08, OBC-03, SC-1) for the post of Junior Personal Assistant in Delhi Transco Ltd. under Post code 56/2013 in the pay scale of Rs. 8500-26300/- having Grade Pay of 3100/- (Pre-revised). Board has conducted One Tier Examination (G) for recruitment to this post on 27.08.2017. Marks of 105 candidates who appeared in the examination and whose OMR sheet have been evaluated have been uploaded on Board's website. Candidates can view their marks by logging into their account in OARS module on www.dsssonline.nic.in.

2. Based on the performance in the examination, 68 candidates who have obtained marks above the cutoff marks, based in the ratio of 1: 10 of the category-wise vacancies subject to attaining minimum qualifying marks and correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms, have been shortlisted for appearing in Shorthand and Typewriting (English) Skill Test. **The short listed candidates shall be called for Skill Test separately.** The category wise cut off marks are as under:

3. The candidates belonging to SC category who were overage in UR category and seeking age relaxation has not been shortlisted in UR category, in view of considering the ratio of 1: 10 of the advertised vacancy in SC category the cut off marks for appearing in Shorthand and Typewriting (English) Skill Test is 87.25 marks.

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4. The OMR sheet of 01 candidate having serial number 202124 has not been evaluated due to wrong bubbling of roll number.

5. The OBC candidates have been shortlisted for appearing in Skill Test in OBC Category, on the basis of details provided by them in their online application forms. The candidates belonging to OBC Delhi are only considered in OBC category.

6. Aforesaid reserved category candidates who have obtained marks above or equal to the last qualified UR candidates and not have availed any relaxation have been declared qualified for appearing in Skill Test against UR vacancies.

7. As per the Board notice dated 26.04.2013, the minimum qualifying marks in two tier written examinations for General candidate is 40%; for OBC candidate is 35%, for SC/ST/PH candidate is 30% and for EXSM candidate is 5% relaxation in their respective categories subject to a minimum of 30%.

8. Mere shortlisting the candidates for appearing in skill test does not confer them any right to selection to the applied post. Final Selection will be made purely on the basis of merit against the notified vacancies provided the candidate falling in the zone of consideration fulfils all the required eligibility conditions. The skill test will be qualifying in nature.

9. While every care has been taken in preparing the list of shortlisted candidates, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions if any, detected at any stage.
