SECTION OFFICER (HORTICULTURE) POST CODE-27/12 IN NEW DELHI MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

The DSSSB vide its advertisement No. 02/12 had advertised total **14** [UR-07, OBC-05, SC-02] vacancies for the post of **Section Officer (Horticulture) in New Delhi Municipal Council, Post Code-27/12** with closing date as 15.06.2012. Tier-I examination in online mode was conducted on **29/09/2019** and **Tier-II Technical Non Descriptive Examination** in offline mode was held on **01.03.2020**.

- 2. Only 01 candidate who had appeared in written examination were informed through notice No. F. No. 211/Result/Section Officer (Horticulture)/Int. Cell/Result/DSSSB/2019-20/3874-81 dated 11/09/2020 on the Board's website i.e. www.dsssb.delhi.gov.in that his marks for the examination dated 01.03.2020 for the post of Section Officer (Horticulture), Post Code-27/12 have been declared and the same were available in their account in OARS module. Further, vide said notice, only 01 shortlisted candidate who qualified the written examination was given the opportunity to upload his documents in the e-dossier module w.e.f. 16.09.2020 to 30.09.2020 with the specific direction that if the candidate fails to upload the e-dossier during the above said period, his/her candidature will be rejected and no further opportunity for uploading e-dossier will be given on whatsoever ground. The shortlisted candidate has uploaded his documents in the e-dossier portal.
- 3. On the basis of marks secured in the written examination and after preliminary scrutiny as per the provisions of the statutory Recruitment Rules for the post and the terms and condition of the advertisement, the following 01 Candidate under UR category is provisionally selected for the post of Section Officer (Horticulture), Post Code-27/12 in New Delhi Municipal Council subject to his fulfilling all other conditions of eligibility and also correctness of the information furnished by the candidate in his online application form and e-dossier:-

01	4780000001 *	The candidate has uploaded copy of certificate with regard to two years experience as Technical Officer 'A' in Defence Institute of Bioenergy Research, Defence research and Development Organization (DRDO), Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India w.e.f. 24.08.2009 to 07.09.2015.

4. * As per RRs, the candidate must have two years experience in Ornamental Horticulture or Land Scaping in Govt, or Semi govt, or organization of repute. Even though, the candidate has uploaded experience in agriculture research on Jatropha and Camelina is different as per requirement of RRs, the candidate is provisionally nominated with the request to the user department i.e. NDMC to thoroughly ascertain the experience of the candidate before issuance of any offer of appointment. If candidate not found eligible, his dossier may be returned after cancellation of his candidature for the post of Section Officer (Horticulture) Post Code-27/12.

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- the documents on the basis of which he has claimed to have fulfilled all the eligibility conditions as prescribed in the RRs and terms and conditions of advertisement inviting applications and subject to thorough verification of his identity with reference to his photographs, signatures/handwriting etc. on the application form, admission certificate etc. The candidature of the above candidate are liable to be cancelled by the User Department also, in case the candidate is found not to be fulfilling the terms & Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letter to the candidates after being satisfied about their eligibility as down in the recruitment rules and after verification of the correctness of the information furnished in the application form and the documents related to Educational Qualification, Age and other essential certificates.
 - Further, if applicable, the User Department shall verify the genuineness of the Caste Certificates furnished by the candidate prior to issuing offer of appointment to the candidate. The Competent Authority of the user department shall arrange to verify the correctness of the information/documents as furnished in the e-dossier vis-à-vis the original documents. User Department is requested to ascertain the scrutiny department of the provisionally selected candidates. Further, the appointing authority shall verify and satisfy itself about the authenticity of documents/certificates and essential qualification for the post before finally appointing the candidate. The User Department is also requested to rectify/correct, in case, any minor/clerical error/deficiency noticed in the documents of the candidate at their own level.
 - 7. It is stated that the User Department shall verify the genuineness of the caste certificate furnished by the candidate in the light of Notification No. 36012/22-93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/1993 issued by DOPT and other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time by the Competent Authority prior to issuance of offer of appointment to the candidate. It is further stated that, prior to appointment, the User Department must satisfy, itself, that the above candidates are fulfilling the necessary criteria as prescribed for entitlement of OBC (Delhi) certificate as specified in various Orders/Guidelines/Circulars including order dated 07/03/2017 issued by Revenue Department, GNCTD after thorough verification of caste certificate.
 - 8. The User Department shall also get the SC/ST/OBC/PH/ExSM/etc. certificates verified from the Issuing authority. Further, if applicable, User Department shall also verify the genuineness of the caste certificates furnished by the candidates prior to issuing offer of appointment to the candidates. In case of the OBC candidates, it may also be verified that the candidate does not belong to creamy layer of the schedule of Govt. of India, DoPT O.M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08.09.1993, O.M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 09.03.2004 and 14.10.2009 and O.M. No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res) dated 27.05.2013 & 13.09.2017.
 - 9. The Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letters to the candidates after being satisfied about his eligibility as laid down in the recruitment rules and after verification of the correctness of the information/documents as furnished in the application form and e-dossier vis-à-vis the original documents related to

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- Educational Qualification, Age and other essential Certificates as per instructions issued by Govt. of India in this regard vide MHA O.M. No. 2/29/54-RPS, 19-11-54.
 - 10. The user department shall ensure that the appointment made is in conformity with DoPT guidelines and instructions of Govt. issued from time to time.
 - 11. The result process for the above post code stands closed in all respect.
 - **12.** As no qualified /suitable candidate available in the merit, there is no waiting panel in the merit list.
 - 13. Mere inclusion of name of candidate in the result notice does not confer any right upon the candidate over the post unless the appointing authority is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respect for appointment to the Post.
 - 14. The category wise marks obtained by the last selected candidates have been given as under:-
