1. The DSSSB vide its advertisement No.03/2013 had advertised total - 02 vacancies (UR-02) for the Post of **Assistant Director (Press & Information)** under Post Code- **49/13 in MCD**. Board Conducted Tier-I examination (online mode) for recruitment in respect of this post on **24/09/2019**. Based on the performance in Tier-I examination (online mode), vide Notice No. 876 dated **16/01/2020**, 12 (Twelve) candidates, were provisionally shortlisted to appear in Tier-II examination (online mode).
2. The online Tier II examination was held on **04/04/2021** and a total of 10 candidates appeared out of the 12 candidates. Vide Notice No. **1146 dated 11/06/2021**, the marks statements of the above Post/Post Code have been uploaded the Board's website for information of the candidates. Candidates can view their marks by logging onto their account in OARS module on www.dsssonline.nic.in.
3. On scrutiny of the documents uploaded by the candidates in the e-dossier module, the candidate bearing following Roll No. in respect of the above mentioned post code has been found to be '**Not Eligible**' in terms of the advertisement no. **03/2013** and Recruitment Rules for the post of **Assistant Director (Press & Information)** under Post Code- **49/13 in MCD**. The candidature of this candidate, therefore, stands rejected:-

The candidate was given two opportunities to submit requisite degree, however, in response; the candidate through a letter in e-dossier link submitted that no language (English, Hindi/Urdu) is taught separately as a subject in B.A. (Hons.) Journalism.
