## GRADE II (DASS) (POST CODE 40/2013) IN SERVCIES DEPARTMENT

The DSSSB vide its advertisement No 03/2013 with closing date 18/10/2013, had advertised 313 vacancies (UR-185, OBC-59, SC-50, ST-19 including EXSM-31, Sportsperson-16, OH-04, HH-04, VH-06) for the post of Grade II (DASS) in Services Department under Post Code 40/2013. Board conducted Tier-I written examination for recruitment in respect of this post on 25.06.2017. Marks of the candidate have been uploaded on Board's Based on the performance in Tier-I written examination, 3269 (three thousand two hundred and sixty nine) candidates, as detailed below, have been provisionally shortlisted to appear in Tier-II exam in the ratio of 1:10 ratio subject to attaining minimum qualifying marks and correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms. The short listed candidates shall be called for Tier-II exam separately. All the candidates can view their marks by logging into their account in OARS module on www.dsssbonline.nic.in.

The candidates having Roll number -14201949, 14206354, 14206834, 14208838, 14212269, 14215223, 14216602, 14216905, 14222035, 14228232, 14229876, 14233438, 14234343, 14234924, 14236414 have not been shortlisted in UR category being overage in UR Category.

Only those candidates have been considered in OBC (Category) who have declared that they had obtained their Caste Certificates from Delhi State in their online application form.

415 candidates who failed to properly mark/bubble their Roll numbers/Booklet Series in their OMR answer sheet have not been evaluated; as such no marks have been displayed against their name.

Since documents have not been called from the candidates alongwith application forms as such detailed scrutiny regarding their eligibility has not been carried out, and therefore, mere inclusion of names in the list of candidates qualifying for appearing in Tier-II examination does not entitle them any right over the post.

Reserved category candidates who have obtained marks above or equal to the last shortlisted UR candidate have been shortlisted against UR vacancies and their final selection to the post shall be considered in UR category, subject to availability of vacancies, otherwise for selection in their respective category.

As per the Board notice dated 26.04.2013, the minimum qualifying marks in two tier written examinations for General candidate is 40%; for OBC candidate is 35%, for SC/ST/PH candidate is 30% and for EXSM candidate is 5% relaxation in their respective categories subject to a minimum of 30%.

The qualified candidates for appearing in Tier-II Examination has been called in the ratio 1:10 of the advertised vacancies, however all the candidates who have scored marks equal to the cut off marks in each category have been short listed.

While every care has been taken in preparing the result, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
