- 1. The DSSSB vide its advertisement No. **01/2015** with closing date **26.11.2015**, had advertised **22 vacancies** (UR-12, OBC-06, SC-03, ST-01 including OH-01) for the post of Draftsman (Civil) Grade-III in NDMC under post code 32/15.
- 2. The DSSSB as per result notice No. 687 dated **10.07.2018**, while declaring the result of above post code, has kept result of 08 candidates in pending list, candidature of 07 candidates for seeking the admissibility of 3 years diploma in Architectural Assistantship/ diploma in Architectural/ diploma in Civil Engineering for the post from the user department and candidature of 02 candidates for additional documents etc.
- 3. As per clarification of user department vide their letter dated **28.06.2019** and after preliminary scrutiny of the candidature of candidates as per the provisions of the statutory Recruitment Rules for the post in respect of the educational qualification and the terms and conditions of the advertisement, these candidates having following roll number are provisionally selected to the post of Draftsman (Civil) Grade-III in NDMC in the Pay Scale of Rs. 8500-26300 Grade Pay 2800/-(Pre-revised) under post code 32/2015.

5. The selection to the above 09 (UR-05, OBC-03 & SC-01) candidates shall be further subject to the thorough verification of the candidature of the candidates by the User Department including the identity of the candidate. The selection is purely provisional subject to scrutinizing the experience details furnished by the candidate in reference to the 02 years essential experience as prescribed in the RRs for the post by the User Department at their own level. DSSSB has not undertaken veracity/ scrutiny of experience certificate being technical in nature. User Department may ensure their scrutiny / correctness at its own level before issue of offer of appointment.

- 6. The candidature of the candidate is liable to be cancelled by the User Department, in case, candidate is found not fulfilling all the eligibility conditions of the Recruitment Rules for the post or any other genuine reason. The decision of the user department/ appointing authority regarding the eligibility of the candidate shall be the final and binding on the candidate.
- 7. The Competent Authority of the user department shall arrange to verify the correctness of the information/ documents as furnished in application forms vis-à-vis the original documents including the educational qualification. Further, the appointing authority shall verify these documents and satisfy itself about the authenticity of documents/ certificates before finally appointing the candidate.
- 8. The Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letter to the candidates after being satisfied about their eligibility as laid down in the recruitment rules and after verification of the correctness of the information / documents as furnished in the application form and e-dossier vis-à-vis the original documents related to education qualification, age and other essential certificate as per instructions issued by Govt. of India vide MHA **OM No. 2/29/54-RRs19-11-54**.
- 9. It is stated that the User Department i.e. Services Department shall verify the genuineness of the caste certificate furnished by the candidate in the light of Notification No. 36012/22-93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/1993 issued by DOPT and other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time by the competent authorities prior to issuance of offer of appointment to the candidate. It is further stated that, prior to appointment, the User Department must satisfy, itself, that the above candidates are fulfilling the necessary criteria as prescribed for entitlement of OBC (Delhi) certificate as specified in various Orders/Guidelines/Circulars including order dated 07/03/2017 issued by Revenue Department, GNCTD after thorough verification of caste certificate.
- 10. The User Department shall also get the SC/ST/OBC certificates verified from the issuing authority before his /her appointment. Further, in case of OBC Candidates, it may also be verified that the candidate does not belongs to creamy layer of the schedule of Govt. of India, DOPT O. M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/1993 O. M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 09/03/2004 and OM No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 14/08/2008.
- 11. The User Department shall also get the SC/ST/OBC certificates verified from the issuing authority before his /her appointment.
- 12. The User Department shall ensure that the appointment made is in conformity with DOPT guidelines and instructions of Govt. issued from time to time.
- Mere inclusion of the name of the candidate in the result notice does not confer any right upon the candidate over the post unless the appointing authority is satisfied after such inquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respect for appointment to the post.
- 14. The recruitment process for the post of Draftsman (Civil) Grade-III under post code 32/15 stands closed in all respect.

- 12. Further waitlist panel/panel for the post code 32/15 stands expired on 09.07.2019 i.e. after one year from the date of declaration of result on 10.07.2018
- 15. The category-wise marks scored by the last candidate provisionally nominated are as under:-
