NOTICE NO. 867 GRADE-IV (DASS)/JR. ASSISTANT (POST CODE 02/17) IN SERVICES DEPARTMENT, GNCT OF DELHI

- 1. The DSSSB vide its Advertisement No. 01/17 with closing date 21/08/2018 and subsequent Addendum dated 01/09/2019 and corrigendum to addendum dated 15/11/2019 had advertised 842 vacancies (UR-400, OBC-170, SC-106, ST-166 including OH-09, HH-48, VH-23, EXSM-129 and SP-24) for the post of GRADE-IV (DASS)/JR. ASSISTANT in Services Department, GNCT Of Delhi under Post Code 02/17. Board Conducted Tier-I written examination for recruitment in respect of this post on 20/09/2019, 24/09/2019, 30/09/2019, 01/10/2019, 03/10/2019 and 04/10/2019.
- 2. The normalized marks obtained by 41710 candidates who have duly appeared in written examination (online mode in multiple shifts) held on 20/09/2019, 24/09/2019, 30/09/2019, 01/10/2019, 03/10/2019 and 04/10/2019 have been uploaded on Board's website. Candidate can view their marks by logging into their account in the OARS Module www.dsssbonline.nic.in
- 3. Based on the performance in Tier-I written examination (online mode), out of these 41710 candidates, total 5404 (Five Thousand Four Hundred and Four) candidates (UR-2402, OBC-1020, SC-636, ST- 1001, OH-54, VH-35, HH-19, EXSM-159 and SP-78) as detailed below, have been provisionally shortlisted to appear in Skill Test/Typing Test in the ratio of 1:6 subject to attaining minimum qualifying marks and correctness of the information furnished by the candidates in their online application forms. The shortlisted candidates shall be called for Skill Test/Typing Test separately.

- 4. Only those candidates have been considered in OBC Category who has declared that they had obtained their caste certificates from Delhi State in their online examination form.
- 5. The candidates having roll numbers 11160200566, 12340221403, 11130206448 and 11230201185 belongs to OBC (Outsiders) thus were considered in UR Category. These 04 candidates were overage in UR category therefore not eligible for shortlisting for Skill Test in UR Category.

- 6. The candidate having roll number 11150207290 OBC (Outsider) thus was considered in UR Category. The Candidate was overage in UR-PH category therefore not eligible for shortlisting for skill Test in PH (OH) Category.
- 7. Since documents have not been called from the candidates along with the application forms as such detailed scrutiny regarding eligibility has not been carried out, and therefore, mere inclusion of names in the list of candidates qualifying for appearing in Skill Test/Typing Test does not entitled them any right over the post.
- 8. Reserved Category candidates who have obtained marks above or equal to the last shortlisted UR Candidates have been shortlisted against UR vacancies and their final selection to the post shall be considered in UR category, subject to availability of vacancies, otherwise for selection in their respective category.
- 9. As per the Board Notice dated 26/04/2013 the minimum qualifying marks in one Tier written examinations for UR Category Candidate is 40%, for OBC Candidate is 35% for SC/ST/PH candidate is 30% and for EXSM category candidate is 5% relaxation in their respective categories subject to a minimum of 30%.
- 10. The qualified candidates for appearing in Skill Test/Typing Test have been called in the ratio of 1:6 of the advertised vacancies; however all the candidates who have score marks equal to the cut off marks in each category have been shortlisted.
- 11. The details of skill typing test shall be notified separately by the Board. The candidates are hereby advised to check the website of the Board regularly.
- 12. While every care has been taken in preparing the result, DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
