- 1. DSSSB vide Result Notice No. 1341 dated 26.08.2021 provisionally nominated Total 50 candidates (PH-OH-UR-01,PH-OH-OBC-01,PH-OH-SC-01, SP-UR-01,SP-OBC-01,UR-04,OBC-35,SC-01 & ST-05) and also provisionally nominated 16 waitlist candidates (PH-OH-01,SP-01,UR-02,OBC-09, SC-01 & ST-02) as per their merit, for the post of Junior Engineer (Civil) under post code 06/19 in DUSIB subject to their fulfilling all other conditions of eligibility and correctness of information furnished by the candidate in their online applicant form and e-dossier.
- 2. The User Department i.e. DUSIB, Govt. of NCT of Delhi vide letters 23.06.2022 and 30.11.2022 has provided report on returned and cancelled dossiers. The User Department has informed that all the nominated and waitlisted candidates under above Category have been utilized and requested to provide additional eligible candidates from the reserve panel of above category under post code 06/19.
- 3. The validity of the reserve panel of post code 06/19 was valid up to 25.08.2022 and the returned dossiers along with complete status report were received in DSSSB prior to expiry of waitlist panel, hence, as per Board's resolution dated 19th May, 2021, in supersession of earlier policy dated 13 June 2019 and in accordance with Services Department Circular No. F.16(3)/DSSSB/2007-S-III/1756-1763 dated 02/08/2021, out of the waiting/reserve panel comprising all the candidates above minimum qualifying marks in Tier-I & Tier-II Examination, the following additional 34 candidates are hereby provisionally nominated from reserve panel of (PH-OH-UR-01, UR-04,0BC-24,SC-01,ST-04) Category under post code 06/19, purely on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the examination held on Online Exam conducted on Nov. 5th & 6th , 2019 and Tier-II conducted on 19.03.2021, as per Board's resolution dated 14/07/2022 with a request to the User Department to utilize the same, in conformity with DOPT guidelines and instructions of Govt. of NCT, Delhi issued from time to time and also mentioned in the result Notice No. 1341 dated 26.08.2021:

The provisionally nomination of above 34 candidates (nominated from reserve panel of PHOH-UR-01, UR-04, OBC-24, SC-01, ST-04 Category has been processed purely on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the examination held on Online Exam conducted on Nov. 5th & 6th , 2019 and Tier-II conducted on 19.03.2021 and also claims made by the candidates in their online application forms of the post code 06/19 for the post of Junior Engineer (Civil)in DUSIB, Govt. of NCT of Delhi. As per the Board's resolution dated 14/07/2022 and as per decision of the Board dated 20/01/2023, the Board has not undertaken scrutiny of documents uploaded in the e-dossiers and other terms and conditions of recruitment notified by the Board in the advertisement of the said post code at this stage. The eligibility as per Recruitment Rules and other terms and conditions as specified in the advertisement no. 01/2019 and relaxations as per rules in respect of educational qualifications, experience, etc. shall be scrutinized/verified

by the User Department for determining eligibility of the candidate for the post code 06/19 as on cut-off date 01.03.2019 before issuance of offer of appointment to the post.

- 6. The User Department, being Cadre Controlling/Appointing Authority, shall strictly follow the merit based ranking of the candidate.
- 7. The candidates in the Waiting Panel or the Balance Reserve Panel shall have no claim or right for appointment per se against the vacancies notified for the recruitment. Nomination of above candidates from Reserve Panel is on the basis of numbers of dossiers returned by the User Department within validity panel in respective categories/Sub-categories. They can only get the offer of appointment only in the event any vacancies (category-wise) arising due to non-acceptance of the offer of appointment, not joining the post after acceptance of appointment, resignation after joining, etc within one year of validity of panel.
- 8. User Department being cadre Controlling Appointment Authority shall utilize the reserve panel subject to availability of candidates in respective categories/Sub-categories and purely on the basis of merit following the relevant circulars/OMs guidelines issued by the Government.
- While operating the waiting panel/reserve panel list, the User Department shall strictly follow instructions issued vide DoPT OM No. 36012/2/96-Estt. (Res) dated 02/07/1997, 36011/1/98-Estt. (Res) dated 01/07/1998 and 43011/4/2018-Estt. (Res) dated 04/04/2018 regarding shifting of candidates from respective reserve categories to the un-reserve category.
- 10. The user department shall operate the waiting panel up to the number of vacancies notified under each category by the DSSSB in its advertisement and not beyond it even by taking any type of relaxation from any authority as it shall rendered the excess appointment void and illegal *Ab initio*.
- 11. As soon as validity period of the waiting panel expires and /or number of notified vacancies are filled up hence waiting panel becomes redundant, the

user deptt. shall return the cancelled and unutilized dossiers to DSSSB with complete details/ statistics forthwith.

- 12. While every care has been taken in preparing the result, the DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
- 13. Wherever the Court has directed to not declare result without leave of the court such cases will be dealt separately, if falling in main result/proposed 20% waiting panel list. The user department shall decide such cases subject to outcome of court case(s).
- 14. Waiting panel has already been expired and was valid upto 25.08.2022.
- 15. The result is subject to the outcome of the court cases, if any, pending in various courts related to this post.
