1. The DSSSB vide its advertisement no. 04/2020 dated 04/01/2020 with closing date 23/02/2020 and subsequent corrigendum dated 14/01/2020 had advertised 09 vacancies (UR-06, OBC-03) for the Post of PGT Fine Arts-Female under post code 84/20 in Directorate of Education.
2. The written examination (online mode in single shift) Tier-I (Technical) for recruitment in respect of this post was conducted on 17/07/2021.
3. The marks obtained by 1002 candidates who have duly appeared in written examination held on 17/07/2021 have been declared vide Notice No. 1243 dated 01/10/2021 and e-dossiers were called between 07/10/2021 to 21/10/2021.
4. On the basis of marks secured in written Examination Tier-I (T) held on 17/07/2021 and having been found provisionally eligible as per documents uploaded in support of educational qualification, age etc., in accordance with the advertisement no. 04/2020 and as per the provisions of the statutory Recruitment Rules for the post, 09 candidates (UR-06, OBC-03) have been provisionally nominated vide Result Notice No.1347 dated 18.01.2022 including the candidate having roll no. **121108400043**.
5. The candidate having roll no. **121108400043** was last provisionally nominated candidate in OBC category on the basis of being older in age than other candidates having equal marks.
6. However, as per Para 2 (viii) of the Vacancy Notice vide advertisement no. 04/2020 dated 04.01.2020, *if there are two or more candidates in the same category having equal marks in the examination in case of One/Two Tier Technical Post, Candidate securing more marks in subject specific section is to be placed higher in merit.* Further, as per advertisement no. 04/2020 dated 04.01.2020 for the post code 84/20 the examination scheme is mentioned One Tier (Technical) exam.
7. Therefore, in view of the above para 2(viii) of the Vacancy Notice advertised vide advertisement no. 04/2020 dated 04.01.2020, candidature of 01 candidate in OBC category having roll no. **121108400043** who was earlier provisionally nominated vide Result Notice No.1347 dated 18.01.2022 in OBC Category, is hereby rescinded and placed as OBC Waitlist-01 candidate by lowering his merit being getting 104.5 marks in subject specific which is lower than the 112.25 obtained by candidate having roll no. **121108400022**.
8. Further, the candidate having roll no. **121108400022** (earlier nominated as OBC WL-01) who secured more marks in subject specific section i.e. **112.25** marks in Section-

B/Part-II than other candidate but both securing equal marks out of 300 (Total Marks) is hereby provisionally nominated in OBC category.

9. The selection of the above 01 candidate in OBC Category shall be further subject to thorough verification of the candidature of the candidate by the User Department including the identity of the candidate.
10. The Selection of the above 01 candidate in OBC Category shall further be subject to genuineness of the documents on the basis of which they have claimed to have fulfilled all the eligibility conditions as prescribed in the RRs and terms and conditions of the advertisement inviting application and subject to thorough verification of their identity with reference to their photographs, signature/handwriting, etc. on the application form, admission certificate, etc. The Candidature of the above candidates are liable to be cancelled by the user department also, in case the candidates are found not to be fulfilling the terms and conditions of the advertisement inviting applications for the said post code. The Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letter to the candidates after being satisfied about their eligibility as down in the recruitment rules and after verification of the correctness of the information furnished in the application form and the documents related to Educational Qualification, Age and other essential certificates.
11. The User Department shall also check the eligibility of the reservation benefit, if any. Further, if applicable, the User Department i.e. Directorate of Education, GNCTD shall verify the genuineness of the caste certificate furnished by the candidate prior to issuing offer of appointment to the candidates. The Competent Authority of the User Department shall arrange to verify the correctness of the information/documents as furnished in the e-dossier vis-à-vis the original documents. User Department is requested to ascertain the scrutiny/correctness of the same at their own level before issuing the offer of appointment to the provisionally selected candidates. Further, the appointing authority shall verify and satisfy itself about the authenticity of documents/certificates and essential qualification for the post before finally appointing the candidate. The User Department is also requested to rectify/correct, in case, any minor/clerical error/deficiency noticed in the documents of the candidate at their own level.
12. It is stated that the User Department shall verify the genuineness of the caste certificate furnished by the candidate in the light of Notification No. 36012/22-93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/1993 issued by DOPT and other instructions/guidelines issued from time to time by the competent authorities prior to issuance of offer of appointment to the candidate. It is further stated that, prior to appointment, the User Department must satisfy, itself, that the above candidates are fulfilling the necessary criteria as prescribed for entitlement of OBC (Delhi) certificate as specified in various Orders/Guidelines/Circulars including order dated 07/03/2017 issued by Revenue Department, GNCTD after thorough verification of caste certificate.
13. The User Department shall also get the OBC certificates verified from the issuing authority before his /her appointment. Further, in case of OBC Candidates, it may also be verified that the candidate does not belongs to creamy layer of the schedule of Govt. of India, DOPT O. M. No. 36012/22/93-Estt. (SCT) dated 08/09/1993 O. M. No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 09/03/2004 and OM No. 36033/3/2004-Estt. (Res) dated 14/10/2008 and OM No. 36033/1/2013-Estt. (Res) dated 27/05/2013 & 13.05.2017.



14. The Competent Authority of the Department concerned shall issue the appointment letters to the candidates after being satisfied about his/her eligibility as laid down in the Recruitment Rules and after verification of the correctness of the information furnished in the application form and the documents related to education qualification, age and other essential certificates as per Government of India instructions issued in this regards vide MHA OM No. 2/29/54-RPS, 19/11/54.
15. The User Department shall ensure that the appointment made is in conformity with DOPT guidelines and instructions of Govt. issued from time to time.
16. While every care has been taken in preparing the result, the DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
17. The category wise marks scored by the last OBC candidate provisionally nominated are remained unchanged which are as under:-

Marks obtained (out of 300)	150.25*

*The candidate who secured more marks i.e. 112.25 in subject specific section i.e. Section-II/Part-II than other candidates having equal marks out of 300 (Total Marks) is provisionally nominated in OBC category.

18. The recruitment process for the Post of PGT Fine Art-Female under post code 84/20 in Directorate of Education, GNCTD has already been closed. Further, the Wait List panel of the candidates shall be valid up to 17.01.2023.
19. Mere inclusion of the name of candidate in the result notice does not confer any right upon the candidate over the post unless the appointing authority is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respect for appointment to the Post.

WAITING PANEL LIST

20. Further in accordance with the Services Department Circular No. F.16(3)/DSSSB/2007-S-III/1268, dated 13/06/2019, the Board prepares and maintains waiting/reserve panel and all the candidates above-minimum qualifying marks in their respective categories are kept in the waiting/reserve panel subject to call of e-dossier/verification of documents. The waiting panel is valid for a period of 1 year from the date of declaration of main result for filling up the vacancies arising due to non-acceptance of the offer of appointment, not joining the post after acceptance of appointment, resignation after joining, etc within one year of validity of panel.
21. Further, as per Board's resolution dated 19th May, 2021, in suppression of earlier policy dated 13 June 2019 and in accordance with Services Department Circular No. F.16(3)/DSSSB/2007-S-III/1756-1763 dated 02/08/2021, out of the waiting/reserve panel comprising all the candidates above minimum qualifying marks in Examination Tier-I (T), the candidate having roll no. 121108400043 is hereby nominated as waitlisted candidate in OBC category as OBC WL-01, in order of merit after scrutiny of their e-dossiers with a request to the User Department to utilize the same, in conformity with DoPT guidelines and instructions of Govt. of NCT, Delhi issued from time to time.



22. The category wise marks scored by the above mentioned waitlist candidates are as under:-

23. The User Department, being Cadre Controlling/Appointing Authority, shall strictly follow the merit based ranking of the candidate in the main list and the waiting list.
24. The User Department, at its own level, will utilize the Waiting List only after exhausting the main list and after affording sufficient opportunity to the provisionally nominated candidates as per the extant guidelines issued by the GNCTD/DoPT.
25. The candidates in the Waiting Panel or the Balance Reserve Panel shall have no claim or right for appointment per se against the vacancies notified for the recruitment. They can only get the offer of appointment only in the event any vacancies (category-wise) arising due to non-acceptance of the offer of appointment, not joining the post after acceptance of appointment, resignation after joining, etc within one year of validity of panel.
26. While operating the waiting panel list, the User Department shall strictly follow instructions issued vide DoPT OM No. 36012/2/96-Estt. (Res) dated 02/07/1997, 36011/1/98-Estt. (Res) dated 01/07/1998 and 43011/4/2018-Estt. (Res) dated 04/04/2018 regarding shifting of candidates from respective reserve categories to the un-reserve category.
27. The user department shall operate the waiting panel up to the number of vacancies notified under each category by the DSSSB in its advertisement and not beyond it even by taking any type of relaxation from any authority as it shall rendered the excess appointment void and illegal *Ab initio*.
28. As soon as validity period of the waiting panel expires and /or number of notified vacancies are filled up hence waiting panel becomes redundant, the user depart shall return the cancelled and unutilized dossiers to DSSSB with complete details/statistics forthwith.
29. While every care has been taken in preparing the result, the DSSSB reserves the right to rectify errors and omissions, if any detected at any stage.
30. Wherever the Court has directed to not declare result without leave of the court such cases will be dealt separately, if falling in main result/proposed 20% waiting panel list. The user department shall decide such cases subject to outcome of court case(s).
31. The result is subject to the outcome of the court cases, if any, pending in various courts related to this post.
